

Call for Papers - WifOR Workshop

Education, Health and Labor Market Outcomes

October 8-9, 2015, Darmstadt/Germany

In times of demographic aging health is an increasingly relevant determinant of productivity. The correlation between education and health is well-documented in the empirical literature. Less is known about causal effects and the mechanisms driving these effects. This multi-disciplinary workshop will provide a forum for empirical researchers in the fields of health, education, and labor research. Topics that will be discussed cover the relationships between education, health, human capital and market outcomes. Presentations may refer to specific issues related to the interaction of education and health, to the intergenerational transmission of health and human capital and to determinants of employability including mental health.

Examples of possible topics for paper submissions

- ✓ Causal effects of education on health outcomes
- ✓ Education, health and early retirement: Health outcomes of the elderly
- ✓ Education, mental health and employability
- ✓ Working conditions, health and productivity
- ✓ Gender specific effects in the skill formation process


