

Call for Papers International Health Economics Workshop

The Committee for International Cooperations of the German Society for Health Economics (DGGÖ) organizes a workshop on Friday, Sept. 6th and Saturday, Sept. 7th at the University of Mainz.

At the workshop, members of the DGGÖ as well as other interested researchers can present current empirical or experimental health economics research that has an “international” dimension, i.e. presenting between-country comparisons or presenting research from one country that provides concrete lessons for other countries. Each presentation will be followed by a discussion. Participation in the workshop implies the willingness to act as a discussant.

A keynote lecture will be given by James P. Smith, RAND Corporation, Santa Monica, California, USA.

The committee for International Cooperations serves as a forum for discussion and point of contact for internationally interested health economists. The workshop is aimed at non-German researchers who are working in, or interested in Germany, Austria or Switzerland, as well as at German researchers who are working abroad, or who are generally interested in international cooperations. For researchers working abroad, we intend to serve as a contact point, in order to enable them to remain in a continuous exchange with German health economics. For researchers working in Germany the committee’s aim is to provide support in establishing relevant international networks and to consequently set up international cooperations and write joint research proposals.

There is no participation fee. Hotel costs for speakers, dinner on Friday (Kloster Eberbach) and lunches are covered. The workshop starts on Friday morning and ends Saturday afternoon, after which there is a facultative guided city tour of Mainz.

There will be a “Best paper award” granting 500 Euros to the best submitted paper by a junior researcher (up to the level of assistant professor). If you are a junior researcher according to this criterion, please indicate so when submitting.
