

10th Workshop of the DGGÖ Health Econometrics Working Group

CALL FOR PAPERS

The workshop aims to bring together researchers who apply econometric methods to answer questions in health economics. We are open to recent methods from the program evaluation literature, machine learning, and classical health econometrics (which model the specifics of, e.g., health and healthcare utilization as dependent variables). We also welcome approaches such as structural econometrics or field experiments. Suitable topics cover among others

- Effects of health insurance on healthcare utilization,
- Effects of long-term care benefits, modes or quality of care,
- Determinants of inefficiencies in healthcare markets,
- The (causal) interplay between human capital and health,
- Using new data (e.g., on genetic endowment, biomarkers or sleep quality) to detect (effect) heterogeneity in health,
- Sources of regional variation in healthcare utilization,
- Intergenerational transmission of health,
- Determinants of the formation and decline of health.

The workshop will take place in Berlin, starting on Thursday at 14:00 and ending on Friday 13:00. We plan to accept six papers, and we will devote 75 minutes to each paper (45-minute presentation, 10-minute discussion by an assigned discussant, and 20-minute general discussion).
