CALL FOR PAPERS

The workshop aims to bring together researchers who apply econometric methods to answer questions in health economics. We are open to recent methods from the program evaluation literature and machine learning as well as to classical health econometrics (like models for unordered, ordered, or count data). We also welcome approaches such as structural econometrics or field experiments. Papers discussed at previous workshops include topics like

- Effects of health insurance on health care utilization;
- Welfare effects of single rooms in nursing homes;
- Effects of education on health;
- Sources of regional variation in health care utilization;
- Effects of maternal labor force participation on child health;
- Reforms in health care provision and quality of care.

The workshop will take place in Linz (Austria), starting on Thursday at 14:00 and will end on Friday 13:00. We plan to accept six papers, and we will devote 75 minutes for each paper (45-minute presentation, 10-minute discussion by an assigned discussant, and 20-minute general discussion).

In this case, please indicate the broad area where you are willing to discuss a paper at the workshop by email until the 15th of October 2023. Participants do not need to be formal members of the working group.
